On the app's home screen, there are 3 selections available.


The Book recommendations page contains a survey to fill out. Fill out as many or as few sections as you wish, then click on submit at the bottom of the screen.






INSTRUCTIONS



When you click on "Reading History", you will see the above screen.



You can add books that you have read to the log. If you make a mistake while entering the book, you have the option to delete the last entry.

When you click on "View Book Statistics", you will be able to see relevant data about the books that you have read, as well as your reading time.



LIMITATIONS

Our app operates with the ChatGPT API, which comes with specific rate limits. Currently, we are using the gpt-3.5-turbo model, which allows for 90,000 tokens per minute or up to 3,500 requests per minute. However, at larger scales, the app's requesting system may experience downtime due to these limits.

Also, the app is dependent on the user for some inputs, such as starting and stopping the timer. Though parents may assist their kids with tracking their reading, it is the user's responsibility to start and end.
