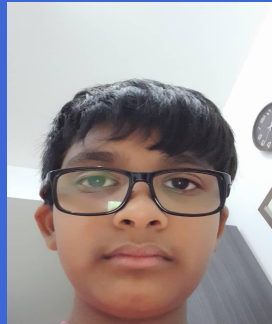

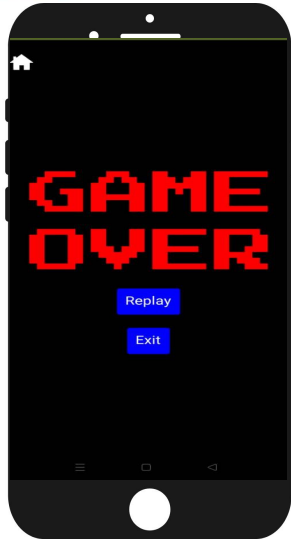
Step 1: (When Button Start pressed it goes to the Next Screen)



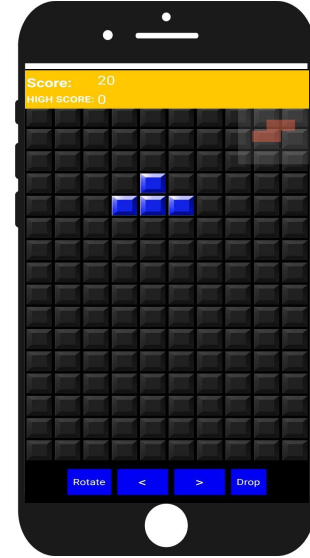
Step 2: (When Button Start pressed the game starts)
