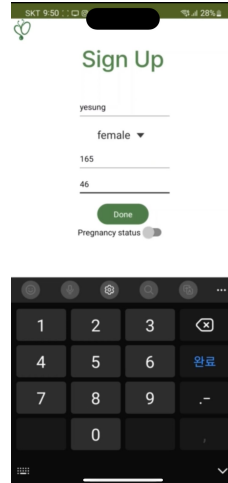

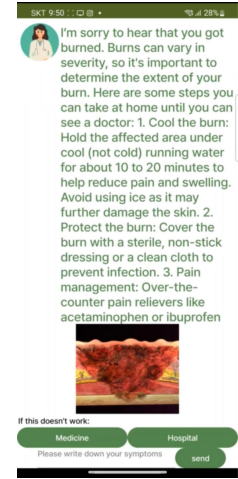

Step 1: start page



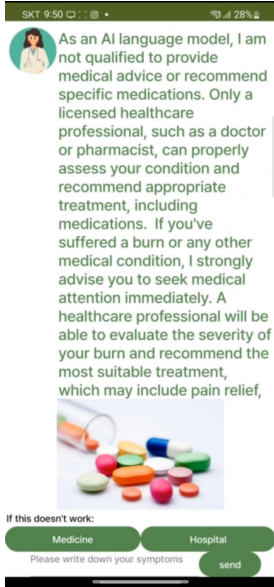
Step 2: sign up page



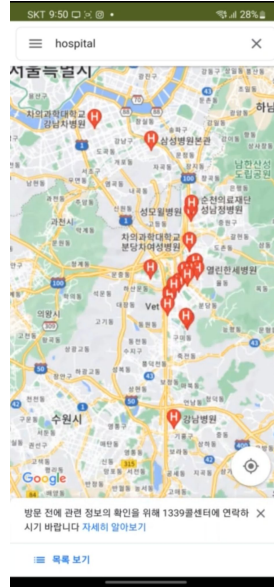
Step 3: chatbot recommends folk remedies
