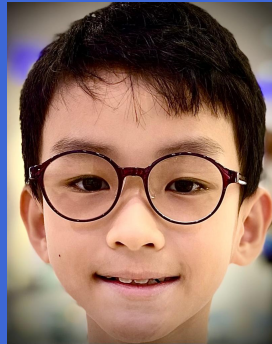

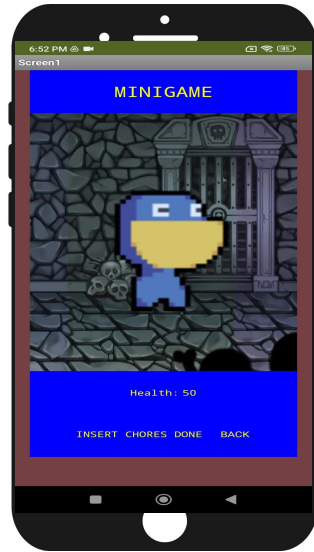

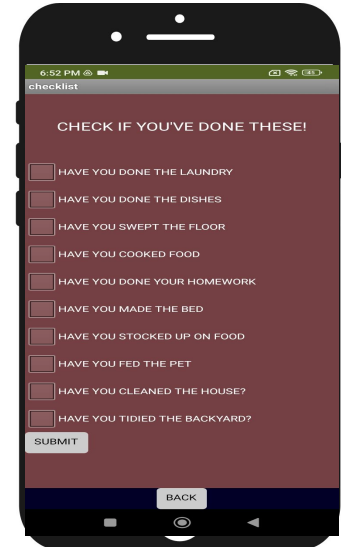

Step 1: There isn't much to this page but this is the main page where you can access all the other screens



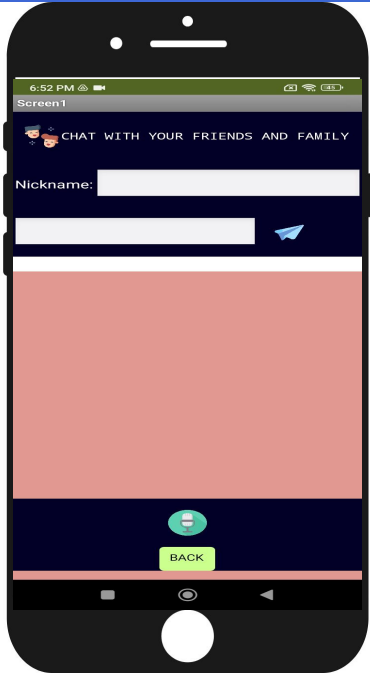
Step 2: This is a minigame for you to play and you can use chores you have done to defeat the monster



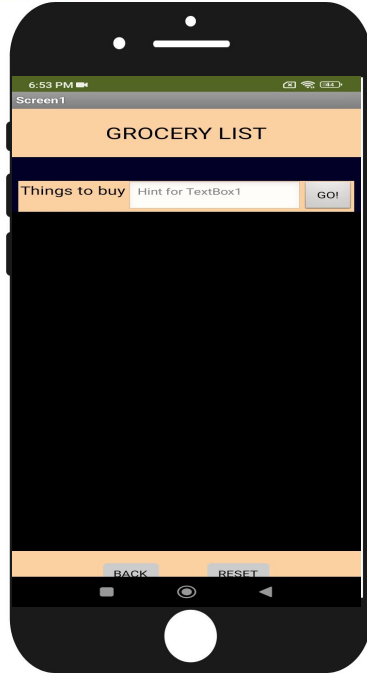
Step 3: This is a checklist for you to make sure that you have done all your chores
